We are writing on behalf of the Nick Finnegan Counseling Center (NFCC), a non-profit making affordable mental health services available to all Houstonians. About one in five Americans has a mental illness, but nearly 60 percent of those people don't get the services they need.

Last year, the NFCC team provided nearly 6,000 counseling sessions – nearly 1,500 more than the previous year with the same number of counselors. While NFCC client fees only cover a portion of operating expenses each year, the remaining expenses are covered by donations from foundations, corporations, and individuals like you. A counseling session costs NFCC \$175, but clients pay no more than \$90 because NFCC wants counseling to be affordable. If \$90 is too much, NFCC offers sliding-scale fee structures and insurance options. Approximately 35% of sessions in 2016 were on the reduced rate sliding scale and because of generous donors like you, NFCC was able to offset the cost of counseling by nearly \$112,000 for clients last year. Thanks to continued support, NFCC is able to offer high quality individualized care with different payment options.

To support NFCC's efforts to keep counseling affordable, we would be honored to have you help sponsor the eighth annual Crack 'em for a Cause Crawfish Boil on March 24, 2018. As event chairs, we will host this all-you-can-eat annual spring fundraiser at **West Alabama Ice House** along with the event Host Committee and NFCC's Advisory Board.
