In fact, because of the sliding scale and insurance options, the average revenue per session is only \$55. Because of this, only 39% of their operating costs are covered by client fees, while the rest is covered by generous donors like you!

As NFCC advocates, we ask for your help underwriting parts of this event that are vital to its success and the success of the organization. Everyone deserves the opportunity to access high-quality, affordable mental health care. A recent review of comparable counseling centers confirmed that NFCC fills a unique niche in the community by offering a top-tier counseling experience at an affordable price.
