We are writing on behalf of the Nick Finnegan Counseling Center (NFCC), a non-profit striving to provide affordable and accessible counseling services to anyone regardless of differences such as age, finances or beliefs. Texas currently ranks last in access to mental healthcare in the U.S. In fact, in Texas there is approximately only one mental health professional per 960 individuals. NFCC hopes to change that by providing high-quality counseling that is affordable and accessible. To accomplish this, they offer low private pay rates, a sliding scale and insurance options.

To support NFCC's efforts to keep counseling affordable, we would be honored to have you help sponsor the 10th annual Crack 'em for a Cause Crawfish Boil on April 4, 2020. As event chairs, we will host this all-you-can-eat annual spring fundraiser at West Alabama Ice House along with the event Host Committee and NFCC's Advisory Board.

To say NFCC has seen incredible growth over the last several years would be an understatement. Each year since its inception, the counseling center has served significantly more clients than the previous year, with over 900 clients served this past year! NFCC also understands that affordable means something different to everyone who walks through their doors, and they never want to turn anyone away due to finances. A counseling session costs NFCC \$175, however clients pay no more than \$95. In fact, because of the sliding scale and insurance options, the average client session brings in only \$68. Because of this, NFCC relies on its generous donors (like you!) to cover more than 57% of the center's total operating costs.

In addition to providing in-house counseling, NFCC has several community outreach partnerships, including those with the Salvation Army and Communities in Schools (CIS), and it also offers various support groups that are free for attendees. One new support group they offered last year was the Survivors of Suicide Loss group, which was for individuals who had lost a friend or loved one to suicide. The participants of this group were able to process grief, find community, and learn techniques to help them connect more closely to their loved ones.

As NFCC advocates, we ask for your help underwriting parts of the Crawfish Boil that are vital to its success and the overall success of the center, and you can find information on sponsorship opportunities here. In return for your generosity, your name or your company's name/logo will be included on event publicity including the invitation, email communications and event signage. Historically, the Crawfish Boil attracts more than 350 attendees, and your participation and generosity will not go unnoticed. We hope you'll become an NFCC supporter to help carry on Nick Finnegan's legacy and help others on their journey towards leading a healthier life.
