We are writing on behalf of the Nick Finnegan Counseling Center (NFCC) which provides affordable and accessible counseling services to anyone regardless of differences such as age, finances, or beliefs. COVID-19 has made the need for affordable mental health services even greater than before and NFCC continues to be vital during these unprecedented times.

COVID-19 brought sustained periods of social distancing and isolation, community-wide grief and stress and record numbers of unemployment. All of these play a role in exacerbating mental health struggles and according to the Kaiser Family Foundation, over half (53%) of adults in the United States reported that their mental health has been negatively impacted due to worry and stress over the virus.

The Nick Finnegan Counseling Center was proud to step in over the last year to help with that burden. Although the majority of their counseling sessions moved to Zoom, they still continue to provide more sessions than ever before. In fact, they provided 8,700 counseling sessions last year which is 1,300 more than the previous year! With low private pay rates of \$95 or less, insurance options and a reduced fee sliding scale, no one is ever turned away from NFCC due to finances.

To support NFCC's efforts to keep counseling affordable, we would be honored to have you help sponsor the 11th annual Crack'em for a Cause Crawfish Boil on April 10, 2021. 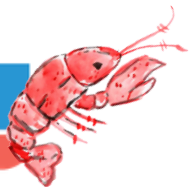
