Did you know the Nick Finnegan Counseling Center (NFCC) provides affordable and accessible mental health counseling to address a variety of issues including anxiety, depression, ADHD, stress management, parent/child relationships, school/behavior issues, trauma, PTSD, addiction, grief and more? With 1 in 5 U.S. adults experiencing mental illness each year and suicide as the 2nd leading cause of death among people ages 10-14, the need is evident. NFCC is making change possible for our community by providing high-quality counseling that is affordable and accessible as well as outreach in the community.

The Nick Finnegan Counseling Center has been prioritizing the mental health of our community since 2011. NFCC now serves clients both in-person and via telehealth, offering a more accessible form of counseling for many clients, and last year they provided over 8,000 counseling sessions. With low private pay rates of \$95 or less, insurance options and a reduced fee sliding scale, no one is ever turned away from NFCC due to finances. In addition to direct mental health counseling, they also offer outreach in the community through support groups in schools, mental health talks in the community and more.
